You **can** get around New York without spending a fortune on cab fare.

Everyone in NY relies on public transportation to some degree, and there are often several ways to get where you want to go. Depending on your destination, it may be just as fast or faster.

1. We're located across the street from LaGuardia airport along a major bus route to the subway.
2. The hotel's free 24-hour shuttle is a great way to access buses that leave directly from the airport.
3. Our parking lot attendant has the commuter fun pass for sale, so you can avoid hunting for two dollars in change to get on the bus. The buses do **not** take dollar bills.
4. When you do want a cab, our central location means we can have you on your way in no time.
5. Our multi-lingual staff will help you plan your route with free maps and directions. Just ask!
6. Our Park and Fly program gives you up to seven days of free, secure parking with a single night's stay. There is no better deal if you plan to drive.

PHOTO GUIDE TO YOUR COMMUTE



Your trip starts with a Metro Card. You can purchase a Fun Pass from our parking lot attendant for \$8.25. The Fun Pass is good for unlimited bus and subway trips until 3am on the day it is activated. Or you can purchase a Pay-As-You-Go card at a subway station. A 7-day pass is \$27; a 14-day pass is \$51.50; and a 30-day pass is \$89.

The bus costs \$2.25 per trip, and if you are paying with cash, you must use coins. The subway is also \$2.25 per trip.

Q33 bus from Ditmars Blvd. to Jackson Heights 74 St-Roosevelt Avenue station

- 7** 7 train goes to Grand Central, Bryant Park and Times Square
- E** E train goes to Lexington Ave, 42nd Port Authority Bus Terminal (United Nations), 34th St Penn Station, Washington Square, Canal Street (Chinatown), World Trade Center (Ground Zero).
- F** F train goes to Roosevelt Island, Lexington Ave and 63rd St, Rockefeller Center, St. Patrick's Cathedral, 5th Avenue Shopping and Bryant Park, 34th St Herald Square (Empire State Building).
- G** G train goes to Brooklyn
- R** R train goes to Broadway (Theater District), NYU, Astor Place (the Village), Prince St, Canal Street, City Hall, Cortlandt St, Whitehall St (Statue of Liberty) South Ferry



The bustop is directly across the street from the hotel (1). The Q33 bus runs every 10-15 minutes from 5am to midnight, and every half hour after that (2). The end of the bus route is the Roosevelt Av-Jackson Hts subway station (3). The bustop for returning to the hotel is directly outside the subway doors when you exit the station (4).

Manhattan / Harlem:

The M60 bus goes direct from LaGuardia airport into Manhattan. It's slower than the subway, but it's ideal if you're heading to Harlem or the upper west side Columbia University area. This can be a crowded bus, particularly in the afternoon. But for \$2.25, you can get into or out of Manhattan in under an hour, door to door.

Bronx Zoo:

Take the Q48 bus from LaGuardia airport to Main St and Roosevelt in Flushing. Get on the Q44 bus to Bronx Zoo-Jamaica. Exit at 180th St and Boston Road. Walk north (right) on Boston Road one block to Asia gate entrance (Gate A).

M60 bus from LaGuardia airport to 125th St/Metro-North station



4, 5 and 6 trains go to Lexington Av, Grand Central 42 St, Astor Place (the Village), Canal St, City Hall, Fulton St, Wall St, Whitehall St (Statue of Liberty) South Ferry. 4 train to Yankee Stadium.

Continue M60 bus to 125 St/Lenox Avenue station



2 and 3 trains go to Central Park North (110 St) before meeting up with the 1 train at 96 St.

Continue M60 bus to 116th St-Columbia University station to Cathedral Pkwy station (110th St)



1 train goes to Lincoln Center 66 St, Columbus Circle 59 St, Times Square 42 St, Penn Station 34 St, Christopher St, Canal St, World Trade Center (Ground Zero), South Ferry (Statue of Liberty)



The free hotel shuttle gets you to LaGuardia (or back) any time, day or night (1). Look for the public bus stop at the terminal, marked with this green sign (2). The M60 bus runs every 7-10 minutes from 6am to 2am, and hourly in the early morning (3). The bus stops at 125th St/Metro-North in Harlem before arriving on the upper west side at 116th St-Columbia University (4).
